Dear Mirians, today May 12th will be the last day of 56 days (4 periods of 2 weeks each) CMO (Movement Control Order). And to be followed by 28 days of CMCO (Conditional Movement Control Order) from May 13th till June 9th. That means most (but not all) businesses will be allowed to reopen upon notifying Sarawak Disaster Management Committee at Miri Resident Office.

CMCO is declared so that most of the businesses can open again. This is important for the country's economy and employment for the people. It is a delicate balance between life/health and business/economy.

I would like to congratulate Mirians for the discipline and orderliness that resulted in Miri being declared as Green Zone on May 9th, after 14 days of consecutive zero positive COVID19 cases. Notwithstanding being declared Green Zone and now the relaxed CMCO conditions, we must not let down our guard and must continue to observe wearing masks, sanitising hands, clean personal hygiene, social distancing, avoid crowded places, to stay at home and not to go out unless absolutely necessary.
