Drain upgrading work at Krokop 7 to complete by year-end

MIRI: Works to upgrade and clear drains at Krokop 7 and Jee Foh 7 are now underway and would be completed by end of this year.

The work completion has been delayed due to the Movement Control Order (MCO), said SUPP Krokop sub-branch chairman councillor Dr Vincent Huang when he inspected the two places recently.

He said flash flood had been a long-term issue the residents there had to face.

"Whenever there is heavy rain, the residents would contact us, worrying that the water level

might rise. The flash flood is actually caused by the rapid pace of development in both areas," he said.

Huang, who is also Krokop Resident Community chairman, said though the delay was unavoidable, he was confident that the works would be completed by December.

"We cannot afford anymore delay because year-end means the monsoon season."

SUPP Pujut secretary councillor Chin Fook Kim and Kapitan Albert Sim were among those who accompanied Huang during the visit.
